O.V. Nix, 88, of Phil Campbell, Alabama, died at home on Friday, July 3, 2020, after a brief illness. Born and raised in the Liberty Hill Community, O.V. was the fifth of eight children born to George Edward Nix and Flossie Ann (Senkbeil) Nix.
