Betty Ann Cox of Haleyville, AL, also known as Momma, Granny, or “Guckey” (by her Great Grandkids), as well as the lady who liked to ride around on the lawnmower in her coveralls with her hair and makeup done, passed away at the early age of 87 on December the 12th, 2018. Betty, aka “Bett” by all her friends and co-workers, was a member of Waldrop Freewill Baptist Church and a shining light to all those that knew her near and far. Bett was a long-time employee of Cox Farms in Haleyville and although referred to as cashier, she was secretly labeled as founder, spiritual and marital advisor, and occasionally known to “preach” a sermon or two in front of all employees during morning coffee break when she thought things just weren’t up to standards. She never once met a stranger and if so, never let them leave without some type of gift or advice and a lip stick mark on the cheek! Those who came frequent were called by name and those who came every once in a while, or were just passing through were referred to as “Sweety” or “Baby”. She was quick to question anyone that was new to the area and before leaving their family tree was completely mapped out along with details and others that “might” be kin and where to find them. She was sharp as a tack and had a caring heart for any and all. She consoled all types from Truckdrivers to Preachers. I wish I had a dollar for every coconut cake she

made and handed out over the years and every bow and flower she sent out to almost every door step in Haleyville. She taught us all to put others first and if anything was left then worry about yourself. She taught us to lay early and rise just the same. Give it everything you got and when the harvest is reaped, be sure to thank God first and the customer next. Granny enjoyed spending time with family and friends and going to "The Galley" and "B and J Cafe" with her dear friend "Bee" on the weekends. She also had a profound love for Matlock, Bonanza, and Professional Wrestling. She would call us up on many Monday nights and say "come put the wrestling on." You could be sure Tuesday morning at work was to be "action-packed" as everybody gathered to hear stories of how Sting came running down the aisle to save Ric Flair and body slammed ole so and so thru a table. It was great. She loved all her Grand and Great Grandchildren abundantly and didn't want to miss one moment nor detail in their lives. She was loved by all and will never be forgotten.

Doubtful that any young persons will read this unless published on Facebook or Social Media, but cherish every moment you have with your Parents or Grandparents. You only get one shot, make the most of it!

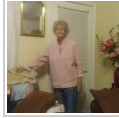

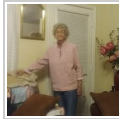

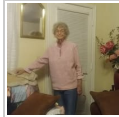
