Gene was a great man, a war hero, but most of all he was a good Christian man, great husband, dad, PawPaw, brother and friend to many. He enjoyed spending time with his family and friends, riding horses, riding motorcycles, camping, hanging out at Jacks and telling his many stories and anyone who knew him will tell you, he was one of the best story tellers.

He joined the National Guard when he was a junior at Phillips High School and went on to enlist in the U.S. Army at the age of 18, he served his country and retired in the Special Forces, Green Beret as a medic. Gene, served two tours of combat in Vietnam, where he was awarded 2 Purple Hearts and a Bronze Star. His career in the Army took him and his family to live in various places, being stationed in Italy, Alaska, Alabama, Georgia, Texas, and California. In 1974 he retired from the Army as a Sargent Major and returned to Phil Campbell, Alabama to settle down.

On November 12, 1960 he married the love of his life Bobbie Hightower, they were married for 52 years before his wife went on to wait for him in heaven for

their reunion. During their time together they were blessed with a son Billy G. Fell, JR (Lisha) and a daughter Tina Fell Seay (Jeff).
