Bobby Glenn Malone, 55, of Russellville, passed away Wednesday, February 16, 2011, at Russellville Hospital.

Bobby was a lifetime resident of Franklin County and attended Calvary Baptist Church. He was currently employed by the Russellville Fire Department and had served as Fire Marshall/Assistant Chief since 2003. Bobby had worked for the Russellville Fire Department for the past 31 years. He became a Lieutenant in the department in 1990. He was chosen Firefighter of the year in 1984 and 2003. He was also a licensed paramedic who worked for Northstar EMS for many years. He received numerous certifications through the Alabama Fire College. He was a member of the Alabama Association of Fire Chiefs, Alabama Association of Fire Marshalls and the National Fire Protection Association.

The funeral service will be Saturday, February 19, 2011, at 11:00 a.m., at Calvary Baptist Church, Russellville, with Wayne Boyles and Alan Compton officiating. The body will be placed in the church one hour prior to the service. Burial will be in Gravel Hill Cemetery, Russellville. The family will receive friends Friday, February 18, 2011, from 5-8:00 p.m., at Pinkard Funeral Home, Russellville.

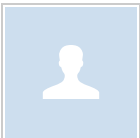
