Marvin Bristol Haughton was born to Kenneth Charles Haughton and Gladys Grimes Haughton in Selma, Alabama, on November 9, 1936. He passed away February 20, 2018. Bristol was a 1955 graduate of Albert G. Parrish High School in Selma. He earned a degree in psychology from the University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee, where he was a Gownsmen in the Order of the Gown and a member of Delta Tau Delta. After several moves across the Southeast, Bristol and his family settled in Haleyville, Alabama, where he made a career in commercial insurance with Tidwell Industries before founding his own agency. 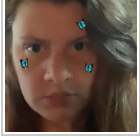

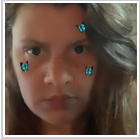
