Dr. Charles Buford Arnold, Ph.D., 81 of Bear Creek, AL., passed away Saturday, April 8, 2017. He was born June 23, 1935 to Homer Issiah and Hazel Rae Arnold. Mr. Arnold was a member of Bear Creek Community Church and a proud veteran, serving in the U.S. Army.

'Buford' , as he was known, earned his B.S. and M.S. from the University of North Alabama and a Ph.D. from Georgia State University. He was a teacher at the Jonesboro and Bremen school systems, worked at the University of Georgia Extension Center, Assistant Superintendent in the Cedartown City School System, Superintendent of the Bremen City Schools, Superintendent of the Cartersville City Schools, Georgia Legislative Lobbyist for the Georgia School System, Educational Consultant with Southern A.E, LLC and Professor at Piedmont College. Mr. Arnold had a Rotarian Scholarship with the University of Oslo, in Norway. Buford's passion above all was to help his students achieve their educational goals.
