November 12, 1942 - September 27, 2011

Charles L. Gibson, Jr., 68, Russellville, Alabama passed away Tuesday, September 27, 2011 at Russellville Hospital.

Mr. Gibson, was a native of Winston County, but had lived in Franklin County for the past 30 years. He was a Southern Baptist pastor for 33 years and a member of Grace Life Church of the Shoals where he taught Sunday school. He served in the Navy and was a member of the American Legion.

Funeral service will be Friday, September 30, 2011, 11 a.m., at Pinkard Funeral Home, Russellville, with Bro. Jeff Noblitt officiating. Burial will follow in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Arley, Alabama. Visitation will be Thursday, from 5 p.m. until 8 p.m. at the funeral home.

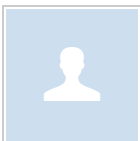
