E. B. Robbins, 86, of Russellville, passed away Saturday, October 11, 2014.

He served in Japan immediately following the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, as an MP, and later as a dispatcher. He was proud of his military service. He was retired from his life's work as a sheet metal worker.

E.B. Robbins was a proud American and a lifelong conservative. Fiercely independent, he treasured his freedom. He was a member of the Church of Christ. He always pulled for the Alabama Crimson Tide. He loved to travel, especially in the western states. In fact, he loved all things western, the stories, the landscape and the culture. He was never seen out unless he was wearing a cowboy hat and boots, many times earning him the nickname, "Cowboy". He was his own man. He will be missed.
