Eugene McCarley, born November 14, 1926, passed away July 20, 2018 in Tuscumbia, Alabama at the age of 91. A native of Franklin County, he graduated from Phil Campbell High School and was a member of Gravel Hill Baptist Church. He was a member of the VFW, the American Legion, and was a proud veteran of the US Army, having served in WWII where he received several medals for his service.

He was retired from Reynolds Metals after 30 years of service. After retirement, he restored antique cars and trucks and won several ribbons and trophies. He was a master mind at repairing and building "anything"--he was a machinist, carpenter, and mechanic. However, his greatest passion was his family: his wife, daughter, and granddaughters (to whom he became Dad as well as PawPaw) and his little "munchkins, his great grandchildren. 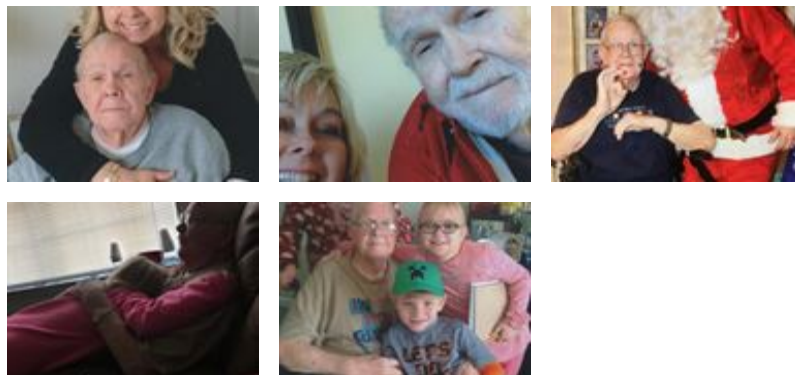
