Frank Frazar Seay, 93, of Russellville, died Friday, September 21, 2012, at Russellville Hospital.

Mr. Seay had been a resident of Russellville for the past 32 years and was a self-employed real estate agent. He was a WWII veteran of the U.S. Navy as a chief petty officer and was a survivor of the Battle of Midway on the U.S.S. Yorktown.

The funeral service will be Monday, September 24, 2012, at 2:00 p.m., at Pinkard Funeral Home Chapel, Russellville, with burial in Tharptown Cemetery. Officiating will be Bro. Douglas Hendon and Bro.
