Ginger Borden Shadix, age 36, a resident of Cypress Cove Care and Rehab of Muscle Shoals, Alabama, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, November 21, 2012, after a prolonged illness resulting from an automobile accident in January 2005.

Ginger was born on February 6, 1976, to Gerald and Jo Ann Borden. She graduated in 1994 from Hillcrest High School in Evergreen, Alabama. She later graduated from Faulkner University, where she received a degree in Early Childhood Education. She completed her Master's degree at AUM. Ginger was an elementary school teacher until the time of the accident. She was a faithful Christian and member of the Evergreen Baptist Church. She also attended Adamsville Church of Christ where she worked with the youth ministry.

Ginger was a devoted and loving daughter, sister, mother and wife. She was an inspiration to all her students and touched many lives. Her smile could light up any room.
