James Allen "Jimmy" Wilson, native of Haleyville and a resident of Gulf Shores, passed away Friday July 26, 2013 at the age of 72. He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Haleyville.

A Memorial service will held at 7:00PM Friday, August 2, 2013 at Pinkard Funeral Home-Haleyville, with visitation from 5:00PM until time of service.

Jimmy was a member of the 1961 University of Alabama National Championship Football team and played for Coach Bear Bryant from 1958 through 1962 season. He graduated from the University of Alabama and attended Howard College of Law(Samford University). While attending Howard he was an assistant coach for his former high school coach Bubba Scott. He served four years with Alabama Air National Guard. He and his lovely wife Jimmie moved to Haleyville in 1966 and began working at Frontier Homes in Sales. Later he became self employed supplier to the mobile home industry. In 1988 he moved his family to Foley, Alabama and began Wilson Candy and Pecan Company.
