



## Jasper Wilton "Red" Taylor

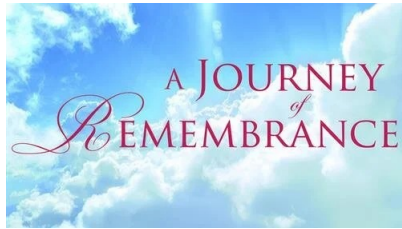
June 4, 1930 - April 1, 2011
