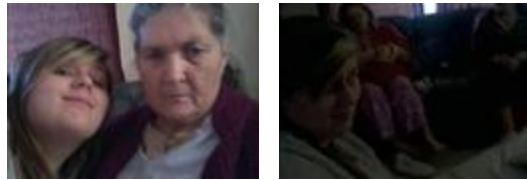
I find it hard to believe that they're both gone. They were 2
