Jerry H. Daily, age 66, Tuscumbia, Alabama, passed away Thursday, September 30, 2010, at Brookwood Medical Center in Birmingham.

Mr. Daily was a native of Franklin County and member of Leighton Baptist Church. He was a graduate of Russellville High School, class of 1962; Walker Junior College, class of 1964; and Florence State College, class of 1966.

He was basketball coach at Colbert County High School from 1968 until 1972, the freshman basketball coach at the University of Alabama in 1973, and basketball coach at Northwest Junior College in Phil Campbell for several years.

After retiring from coaching, he owned and operated Tennessee Valley Stockyard in Florence from 1988 until 1995. He then became a salesman for Vulcan Materials and established his own company, Daily Ag Products.

Funeral service will be Saturday, October 2, 2010, 2 p.m. at Pinkard Funeral Home in Russellville with Rev. Tom Whatley, Leon Douglas, and Bill Pritchard officiating. Visitation will be prior to the service from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. Burial will be Sunday, 2 p.m. at Bethany Baptist Church Cemetery in Horton, Alabama, with Manley Norris officiating.

Survivors include wife, Sharon Daily, Tuscumbia; sons, David Daily and wife, Sarah, Hayden, Alabama and Jason Daily, Birmingham; brother, Larry Daily and wife, Glenda, Russellville; two nieces; one nephew; longtime friend, Billy and wife, Julie Schroeder.
