John Leland Richeson joined the Lord late Sunday evening after dying peacefully at home following a brief illness. John was born January 10, 1930 in Cherry Hill, Alabama, attended Russellville High School where he played football. He enlisted in the Air Force and attained the highest enlisted rank (Chief Master Sergeant) and retired after more than 27 years of service. His service included assignments in Germany, Nevada, Korea, Japan and Vietnam-where he earned the Bronze Star Medal. Following his 1974 retirement he returned to Cherry Hill and became a loan officer with the Russellville Production Credit Association. John was an active member of the Cherry Hill Baptist Church and was recently honored with a Veteran's Memorial in the Cherry Hill Cemetery for his military service and his cemetery support. John will be remembered as a devoted Christian, loving husband and father, and true patriot. His interest included community service, travel and military history. He is survived by Ann his childhood sweetheart and wife of 59 years; daughters Debra Donovan, Susan Newman, and Mary Jones; Six grandchildren Katie, Lucy, John, Andy, Will and Thomas; three great grandchildren Emma, Nolan and Caroline; and his brother James Richeson.
