Johnnie Monroe Wilson, 97, of Russellville, passed away Saturday, August 16, 2014 at ECM Hospital.

Mr. Wilson was a native of Eutaw, Alabama, but had lived in this area for many years. He was a member and active deacon of Southside Baptist Church. He was retired from the Department of Agriculture Soil Conservation Service and was WWII veteran of the U.S. Army.
