J. T. Hendrix, 93, of Russellville, died Tuesday, November 22, 2011, at ECM Hospital.

Mr. Hendrix was a native of Russellville and was retired from U.S. Pipe-Jim Walters Resources with 40 years of service. He was a member and deacon of First Baptist Church, Russellville, for over 75 years. He served on the Executive Committee of the Franklin County Baptist Association for 20 years. 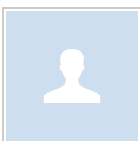
