March 21, 1931 - August 9, 2025

Mary Pyron Lambert, 94, of Savannah, Tennessee, was born March 21, 1931, in Counce, Tennessee, and departed this life on August 9, 2025, in Haleyville, Alabama.

She was the second child of Owen and Emma Fields Pyron.

Mary graduated from Shiloh High School in 1949 and married Herman Lambert, on April 15, 1950. In the fall of 1953, Mary and Herman moved “across the river” to make their home in Walkertown. She was a devoted member of Barnhill Methodist Church, where she faithfully served in many capacities, and was honored to be its oldest member.

A gifted seamstress, Mary could create anything from doll clothes to ballet costumes for the Birmingham Ballet. Later, she worked for more than 20 years in the fabric department at Wal-Mart, where she shared her knowledge of fabrics, patterns, and sewing techniques with countless customers.
