He is preceded in death by his father, Henry Meldon "Son" Parson; wife, Mary Parson; and brother, Billy Neal Parson.

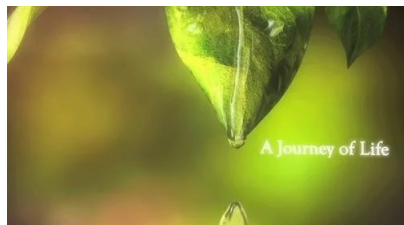
In lieu of flowers memorials may be made to Free State Four Paws or St. Jude.

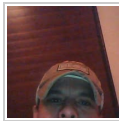
