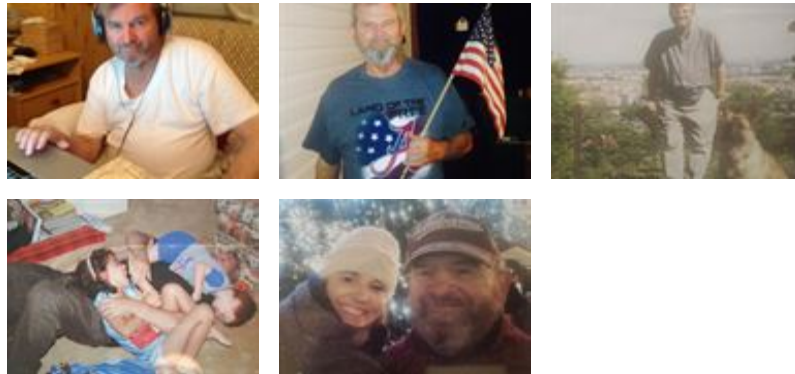

“ I met Mike in Prague in 1991 or '92. I visited there in '91 and moved there in '92. Mike was not an evangelist then. Every day he went into the streets of Prague, set up a table of Bibles and brochures, and convinced Czechs who passed by to study the Bible with one of the American preachers there at the time.
