June 19, 1923 - April 3, 2010

Quinon L. Finley , age 86, Haleyville, Alabama, passed away Saturday, April 3, 2010 at his residence in Haleyville. He was a lifelong resident of Haleyville, where he owned and operated Finley Lumber and Crate Company,. Inc. He served 12 years as a city council member. He was a 50 year member of Masonic Lodge and a deacon at Corinth Heights Baptist Church for 54 years. As a World War II Air Force veteran, Mr. Finley flew 52 missions against the Japanese in the China-Burma-India Theater. He was a member of CBI Hump Pilots Association.
