Ernest Ralph Pendley, age 76, of Lynn, Alabama, passed away on Sunday, December 29, 2013 in Winfield, Alabama. He was co-owner of Basic Supply Company in Lynn with his partner, Jerry Coan, for 43 years. Ralph was a long-time member of Lynn Baptist Church where he served as the church treasurer for many years.
