



Roscoe Dewey Fleming

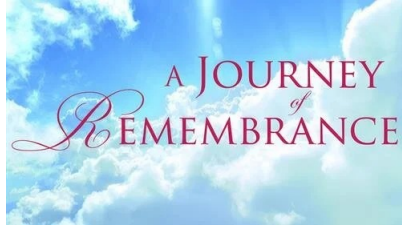
July 8, 1914 - February 27, 2011
