Sylvan Watts Cole, 72, of Russellville, AL passed away Friday, April 21, 2017 at his home. A native of Russellville and resident for most of his life, Mr. Cole was a financial advisor and retired from Wells Fargo Advisors after 29 years of service. A 1962 graduate of Russellville High School, he earned a Bachelor's Degree from Auburn University in Business Administration. He was a long time member of the First United Methodist Church, Russellville.
