Thomas Joseph "Joe" Miller, age 88, of Haleyville, Alabama passed away Saturday May 12, 2012 at home. Visitation will be Monday May 14, 2012 from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. at Pinkard Funeral Home, Haleyville. Funeral service will be Tuesday May 15, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. at Waldrop Freewill Baptist Church in Haleyville. He will lie in state at the church from 1:00 until 2:00 p.m., burial will follow at Littleville Cemetery. Thomas was born in Winston County, the son of the late Chris and Ida Miller. He was a member of Waldrop Freewill Baptist Church, he was a World War II Veteran, served as a Military Policeman in the United States Army. His tour of duty was in New Guinea, Southern Phillipines (Liberation) Luzon. His Decoration and Medals includes the Bronze Star Medal, WWII Victory Medal, APTO Medal. Private Miller was present at Tokyo Bay at the signing of the Peace Treaty, aboard the USS Missouri in Tokyo Bay, Japan on September 2, 1945 which ended World War II. Thomas was retired from Illinois Central Gulf Railroad. He is survived by his wife, Elene; children, Edith (Wayne) Crumpton and Jolene (Harold) Stults; grandchildren, Scott Crumpton (Vicki), Susan (Nathaniel) King, Amy (Jeff) Williams; 1 great grandchild, Logan Oliver; brothers, Athan Miller, Drexell Miller, Fletcher Miller and David Miller; a host of niece's and nephew's. He was preceded in death by his parents, Chris and Ida Miller; brother, Cecil Miller; sisters, Geraldine Oliver, Devona Treese and Martha Timmons.
