



## Trubie Nell Adamson

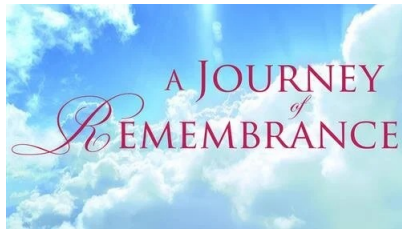
October 21, 1934 - January 24, 2013
