September 13, 1919 - May 25, 2011

Former long time Alabama resident Vernon L. Taylor, age 91, passed away on Wednesday, May 25, 2011, in Murfreesboro, Tennessee, where he had been a resident since 1986. He was born in Franklin County, Alabama, on September 13, 1919.

Mr. Taylor was an active member of the Church of Christ both in Alabama and Tennessee. He was an army veteran and served his country during World War II and then worked for approximately 30 years at Union Carbide Corporation in Muscle Shoals, Alabama.
