Virgie Courington Dupree, 88, Natural Bridge, AL. passed away Wednesday April 14, 2010 at her home. She was the oldest surviving member of Concord Baptist Church, a lifelong Republican and served on the Natural Bridge Town Council. She was selected as the first woman to serve on a Grand Jury in the state of Alabama. She was also an avid gardener, the first librarian at Lynn and a member of Eastern Star.

Funeral service will be held Saturday April 17, 2010 at 11:00 AM at Concord Baptist Church with Richard Crumpton and Bobby Aderholt officiating the service. Burial will follow in the adjoining church cemetery.

Mrs. Dupree is survived by her children, Jimmy Courington and Anna Vickery; sister, Marie Litton; grandchildren, Renee, Donna & David; great grandchildren, Hannah & Ben Wendlandt, Anna & Alex Beaver, Olivia Grace Courington.
