William Harold Halcomb, 70, of Phil Campbell, passed away March 20, 2013.

Visitation will be March 22, 2013, from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m., at Pinkard Funeral Home, Russellville. His funeral service will take place at 11:00 a.m., on Saturday, March 23, 2013, in the funeral home chapel. Burial will follow at Winston Memorial Cemetery in Haleyville.

Harold was born April 4, 1942, in Five Points, Alabama. He graduated from Phil Campbell High School in 1959, and joined the Navy in June of that year. He served until 1965 as a SFP2. After his honorable discharge, he was employed at Reynold's Metals, where he was an iron worker. Following retirement from Reynold's, he followed his dreams by founding both Smoke and Feathers and Harold's Primitive Shop. He sold his business and retired "again" in 2007.
